

## FALL 2019 WORKSHOP FOR WHITE PEOPLE



This workshop series is BRJA's introductory class for white people. Participants will explore the historical development as well as the contemporary implications of racism in the United States, as well as our own racialization as white people. Participants will work with learning partners to develop an anti-racist action plan to help them deepen their own understanding and to grow their practice of taking conscious action for racial justice in their own circles of influence. Participation will require a commitment of 32 hours of classroom time, plus 2-4 hours between sessions for reading and meeting with a learning partner.
